





Ad 1. With recent changes in leadership across some of the institutions, it's opportune for the rectors to reflect on our experiences with the alliance's successes and areas for improvement. I encourage each rector to prepare a 10-minute presentation, followed by a discussion on common issues. This presents a valuable opportunity to acquaint ourselves with the new leadership and foster stronger connections within our alliance.

Task for each rector: a 10 min presentation of successes and needed improvement of our alliance.

Ad 2. During the governing board meeting in Split, we were challenged by the WG responsible for Legal status to define our goals with greater precision. What objectives do we, as an alliance, aim to achieve with a Legal status? Within all of the alliances financed by EU there has been some pilot projects for Legal status. These pilot projects present their findings in April. Laura and Juan participate in this meeting and will provide us with updates. This session, led by Juan Ramón Real, aims to facilitate discussions on alliance goals achievable through Legal status. We intend to provide written updates to rectors in advance for institution-level discussions prior to our meeting in Bodø.

Task for each rector: Discuss, within your institution, issues outlined in the provided documents sent to you ahead of the Bodø meeting.

Ad 3. It takes long time to organize funding at the level we have received from EU. We are already 1,5 years into the second period for the EU financing. I propose that the rectors receive an update from general coordinator about possible further financial support from EU. Following this update, we should have time to discuss other financial options instead of or in addition to funding from EU after 2026.

* - Saltstraumen, located 30 km or about 0.5 hours from Bodø's city centre (20 minutes from Campus), is a fascinating natural phenomenon famous for hosting one of the world's strongest tidal currents. It is renowned for having one of the world's strongest tidal currents, creating powerful whirlpools and eddies as the tide rushes through a narrow strait between the Saltfjorden and Skjerstadfjorden.

We will also go on a short hike.

- In contrast, Mjelle Beach, also just a short drive from Bodø at 30 km or about 0.5 hours from the city centre (40 minutes from Campus), offers a peaceful escape from the dynamic energy of Saltstraumen. Known for its pristine white sands, crystal-clear waters, and breathtaking coastal scenery, Mjelle Beach provides an idyllic setting for leisurely strolls along the shoreline.

The weather in Bodø can be unpredictable, therefore it is advised to pack with and dress in warm clothes:

- Mittens/gloves
- Scarf
- Rain and windproof coat
- Waterproof shoes



- From the city centre to campus we will provide bus transport for all participants. The buses leave at 8 am (May 28, 29 and 30) from Hotel Thon Nordlys, Moloveien 14.



Airport




- Bodø Airport is located close to the city center, approx 10km from the university
- If you have accommodation in the city, it is a short walk (~1 km) from the airport. Otherwise, bus and taxi is easily available.
- Public bus, price 39 NOK.
 - Route 1 and 2 takes you to the city centre in 5 minutes. The leave every ten minutes in daytime, less often at night and weekends.
 - You can purchase tickets in the app «Reis Nordland» or buy a ticket on the bus (No cash + added 20 NOK (~2 EURO) fee for buying on the bus).
- Taxi
 - Bodø taxi, has a taxi stop outside the airport. If there are no taxis, call +47 07550 (ca. 5 minutes drive from airport to city centre ~150 NOK (~15 EURO))

Campus Bodø

If you miss the shuttle bus or want to come to campus at another time, you can easily reach the campus by public bus.


- Public bus, price 39 NOK.
 - Route 1 and 2 takes you from city centre to the university (ca. 30 minute bus ride). The leave every ten minutes in daytime, less often at night and weekends.
 - You can purchase tickets in the app «Reis Nordland» or buy a ticket on the bus (No cash + added 20 NOK (~2 EUR) fee for buying on the bus).



- Taxi
 - Bodø taxi, call +47 07550 (ca. 15 minutes drive from city centre to the university, ~300 NOK (~30 EURO))


You can go to Jakhell Brygge, where Nord University has two meeting rooms on the second floor.


